

## Canllawiau ymddygiad disgyblion diogel ysgol y Moelwyn - Medi 2021

Rydym yn edrych ymlaen at eich croesawu nôl i'r ysgol!

Rydym i gyd yn deall bod rhaid cael safonau uchel iawn o safbwynt ymddygiad diogel er mwyn i'r ysgol agor yn saff.

Bydd staff yr ysgol yn eich atgoffa i gadw'r rheolau diogelwch yn gyson. Hefyd mae posteri a chanllawiau gweledol yn yr ystafelloedd dosbarth a'r coridorau. Maen nhw yna i'ch atgoffa am y rheolau diogelwch yn gyson ac er mwyn eich cadw chi a'r staff yn saff.

Ein dymuniad ydy cadarnhau ein disgygliadau yn glir o ran ymddygiad diogel pob disgybl. Mae'r disgygliadau wedi eu seilio ar yr egwyddor fod gan bob aelod o staff yr hawl sylfaenol i wybod y bydd pob unigolyn arall, staff a dysgwr, yn parhau'r rheol pellter corfforol ac yn ymddwyn yn ddiogel.

Mae'r isod yn ychwanegol ar ddisgygliadau ymddygiad arferol yr ysgol.

- **Rheol pellter corfforol:** Mae'n rhaid cadw pellter corfforol oddi wrth oedolion. Mae'n bosibl ein bod yn cytuno hefo'r rheol hon neu ddim yn cytuno hefo hi. Nid yw hynny'n gwneud gwahaniaeth. Os nad ydych yn dymuno cael yr hawl hwn nid yw'n rhoi caniatâd i chi ei dynnu oddi ar eraill.
- **Cyrraedd yr ysgol:** Pan fyddwch yn cyrraedd yr ysgol byddwch yn cael canllawiau ble i fynd tan i'r diwrnod ddechrau – mae hyn yn ddibynnol ar y tywydd.
- **Diwedd y diwrnod ysgol:** Ar ddiwedd y diwrnod ysgol byddwch yn gadael yn drefnus er mwyn gwneud yn siwr nad oes gormod o ddisgyblion hefo ei gilydd.
- **Loceri:** Gallwch ddefnyddio'r loceri a disgyblir i chi eu cadw'n lân.
- **Amser egwyl a chinio:** Byddwch yn cael canllawiau pendant ble i fynd yn ystod cyfnod egwyl a chinio.
- **Bysiau ysgol preifat a phreifat :** Byddwch yn cael canllawiau pendant ar y bysiau preifat. Byddwch hefyd angen dilyn canllawiau'r gyrrwr wrth adael y bus yn saff. Disgyblir i chi wisgo mwgwd ar y bysiau.
- **Iechyd:** Mae'n debyg mai anaml iawn y bydd dysgwyr yn pesychu yn yr ysgol bellach gan y byddwch, os ydych yn pesychu yn eich cartref, angen aros adref am resymau diogelwch. Os ydych yn pesychu dylech roi eich penelin/braich dros eich ceg a throi i ffwrdd oddi wrth bawb arall.
- **Ydach chi'n iach i ddod i'r ysgol?:** O oes gennych beswch newydd parhaus, gwres uchel neu rydych wedi colli synnwyr arogl a blas, ni ddylech ddod ar safle'r ysgol o gwbl.
- **Camymddwyn:** Mae esgus pesychu yn cael ei gyfrif yn hollol annerbyniol. Fydd esbonio ymddygiad o'r fath trwy ddweud mai joc ydy'r digwyddiad ddim yn cael ei dderbyn.
- **Menthyg offer:** Nid yw'n bosibl menthyg offer bellach gan neb – gan ddisgybl arall nag athro. Felly rhaid dod â'ch holl offer i'r ysgol. Gwnewch yn siwr fod gennych yr isod:

### Offer ac eitemau eraill

- Potel ddŵr.

- Llyfrau gwaith y pynciau yn unol â'r amserlen, llyfr nodiadau (gallwch gael un gan yr ysgol os nad oes gennych un yn barod).
- Beiros, pensiliau, glud, siswrn (heb ben pigog) a chyfrifiannell.
- Hand gel.
- Er mwyn osgoi rhannu offer, mae croeso i'ch plentyn ddod â chromebook neu laptop ei hun i'r ysgol ar ei gyfrifoldeb ei hun. Os ydy eich plentyn am ddod â gliniadur i'r ysgol, mae'n bwysig ei fod wedi ei wefru yn barod. Bydd rhai pwyntiau gwefru yn unig ar gael yn yr ysgol.

- **Prynu offer:** Gallwch brynu offer yn yr ysgol. Os ydych am wneud hyn byddwch angen defnyddio eich cyfrif cinio ysgol i dalu am yr eitemau hyn.
- **Defnyddio gorchudd wyneb:** Mae Cyngor Gwynedd yn **disgwyl** bod disgyblion sydd dros 11 oed yn gwisgo gorchudd wyneb pan yn teithio ar gludiant dynodedig ysgol a choleg (boed hynny'n fws neu dacsî). Mae hi'n **hanfodol** gwisgo gorchudd wyneb i deithio ar wasanaeth cyhoeddus. Mae croeso i chi ddefnyddio mygydau, os ydych yn dymuno, yn y manau prysur yn yr ysgol. Disgwylir i chi wisgo mwgwd yn y ffreutur.
- **Toiledau:** Peidiwch ag ymgynnull fel grŵp y tu allan i'r toiledau a chofiwch eu cadw yn lân.
- **Profion llif unffordd:** Anogir pob disgybl, yn dilyn caniatâd ffurfiol gan riant, i gwblhau profion llif unffordd bob nos Sul a nos Fercher. Os yw canlyniad prawf yn gadarnhaol, dylech roi gwybod i'r ysgol ac aros gartref. Byddwch angen hefyd rhoi gwybod i'r gwasanaeth cofnodi a dilyn eu canllawiau (gweler canllawiau manwl).

## Ysgol y Moelwyn's pupil behaviour guidelines – September 2021

We are looking forward to welcoming you back to school!

We all understand that there must be very high standards in regards to safe behaviour in order for the school to open safely.

Staff at the school will consistently remind you to keep to the safety rules. In addition, there are posters and visual guidelines in the classrooms and corridors. They are there to remind you of the safety rules and to keep you and staff safe.

Our wish is to confirm our expectations clearly in regards to all pupils' safe behaviour. The expectations are based on the principle that every learner and every member of staff have a fundamental right to know that every other individual, staff and learner respect the 2-metre rule and behave safely.

The following points are an addition to the school's usual expectations of behaviour.

- **Physical distance rule:** We must keep physical distance from adults. It is possible that we agree with this rule or do not agree with it. This does not make a difference. If you do not wish to have this right, it does not give you permission to remove it from others.
- **Arriving at school:** When you arrive at school, you will be given guidance on where to go until the day starts – this is dependent on the weather.
- **End of the school day:** At the end of the school day you will leave in an orderly fashion, to ensure that there are not too many pupils together.
- **Lockers:** You will be permitted to use your locker and you are expected to keep it clean.
- **Break and lunchtime:** You will be given clear guidelines on where to go during breaks and lunch.
- **Private and public school buses:** If you use a private school bus, you will be given specific guidelines. You will in all cases need to follow the driver instructions. You are expected to wear a mask on the bus.
- **Health:** It is unlikely that any learner will cough in the school because if you cough at home you will need to stay home for safety reasons. If you do cough, you should place your elbow/arm over your mouth and turn away from everyone else.
- **Am I healthy enough to come to school?:** If you have a new, continuous cough, high temperature or have lost your sense of taste/smell, you should not come on the school site at all.
- **Misbehaving:** Intentional coughing is considered as totally unacceptable. To explain such behaviour by saying that it is a joke will not be accepted.
- **Borrowing stationery:** It will not be possible to borrow any stationery or equipment – from another pupil or from the teacher. You will need to bring all your stationery to school. Make sure you have the following:

### Equipment and other items

- Water bottle.
- Subject books in line with the timetable, notebook (available in school if needed).

- Biro, pencils, glue, scissors (with blunt end) and calculator.
- Hand gel.
- To avoid sharing equipment, your child is welcome to bring their own chromebook or laptop to the school, at their own responsibility. If your child wants to bring a laptop to school, it is important that they have already been charged. There will only be a few charging points available at the school.

- **Buying stationery:** You can buy stationery and equipment in the school. If you want to do this, you will need to use your school lunch account to pay for these items.
- **Using a face covering:** Gwynedd Council **expect** that all pupils 11 years old and over wear a face covering when travelling on specific school and college transport (bus or taxi). It is **essential** to wear a face covering when travelling on public transport. You are welcome to use face masks, if you wish, in the busy areas of the school. You are expected to wear a mask in the school canteen.
- **Toilets:** Do not assemble as a group outside the toilets and remember to keep them clean.
- **Lateral flow testing:** We encourage every pupil, if a formal consent has been provided by parents/carers, to complete a lateral flow test every Sunday and Wednesday evening. If the test results are positive, you should notify the school immediately and stay at home. You will also need to notify the official service by following the guidelines (see manual guidelines).
