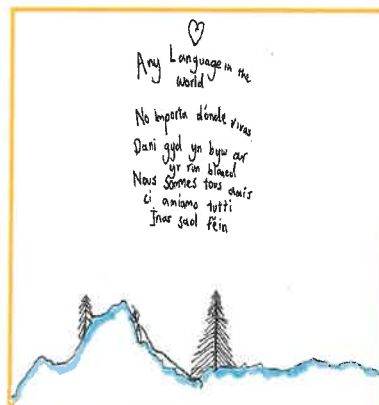

Gwenfair joined us as a shy pupil from Ysgol Tanygrisiau and over the years she matured into a good-natured and gracious individual. She was a hardworking and conscientious pupil who always showed dedication to her studies. Within lessons she was quiet – there was no need for her to even utter a word as her smile gently reminded us of her presence. She was gifted with a caring and endearing personality and treated everyone with respect - she never had a bad word to say about anyone. Although she appeared to be quiet and shy, in the company of her friends she was a 'big personality', indeed she was a rock for them and she always prioritised others. Her laughter was infectious - once she started there was no stopping her! She had a quiet sense of humour yet always understood a joke. Mrs Morris remarked that the knowing look she gave when someone said something silly in class was evidence of Gwenfair's shrewd nature.

She had a keen interest in so many different things - she enjoyed listening to music and would retreat into her own little world wearing her beloved headphones. Reading, spending time with friends and playing board or electronic games, especially chess were also things she enjoyed. She had many skills and could accomplish so many things, ranging from cooking delicious brownies to creating impressive works of art. Being in nature was important to her; she liked animals and her art book was full of flowers, birds and cats. She would often go wandering on local paths with those closest to her heart: her friends and family. She was so proud of her community and was very much aware of her environment. Her art work was truly wonderful, especially the picture of a colourful bird she created. She would enjoy carving pumpkins, photography and designing anything that made her feel happy. Her work was colourful and delicate, using light colours and a quiet touch, exactly like Gwenfair. She didn't enjoy any public praise or fuss, but when being praised in private, her face would light up with pride. She also had hidden talents, including ice skating. She had her own skating shoes and when joining us on our annual visit to Deeside, the shoes provided by the centre were always a concern as they were not sharp enough!

Her favourite subjects were Physics, Art and History and she was always the first to turn up for registration every morning with Miss Sharon Davies. There were a few things which she didn't like such as meeting new people, shopping (she would usually sit in the car!) and finally, she really didn't like the Bac course!

Although a shy individual in public, this was not the case with her closest friends as she was completely at home with them. She enjoyed their fun and companionship and was a faithful friend who cared for others. She gave her time and support to others, even during the maths lessons! She looked after her friends, and she had the ability to boost their confidence and encourage them to see the best in themselves.

She was a really wonderful youngster with a big personality. These words summarize everything about her: she was a 'truly lovely young lady'.

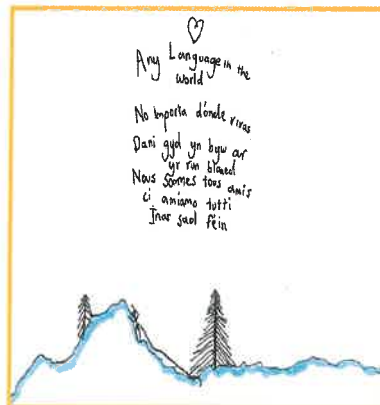
